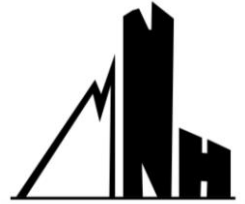




CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS 11th Annual Contemporary Juried Art Exhibition 2018

**Kirkland Lake Contemporary Art Committee
& the Museum of Northern History**



The Museum of Northern History and the Contemporary Art Committee will host the 11th Annual Contemporary Art Exhibition. Artists at all stages in their career are eligible and all disciplines are welcome.

Theme: Tranquility

The intent of this theme is to invite artists to contemplate, meditate and be inspired internally or externally with a serene state of mind. Moments in our lives ask us to take time away from the routine and engage in a personal exploration of one's self.

Artists are encouraged to explore settings, colours, ambiences, smells, sounds, flavours, etc...in the creation of their works. The artwork should invite us to broaden our minds, reflect, become aware and enjoy our living presence.

The word tranquility is associated with personal joy and what it means individually to feel soothed, composed, relaxed, collected, stress-free, calm, safe, undisturbed, etc...

This exhibition is open to all artists, with the intention of bringing together a range of mediums, thoughtful responses and interpretations.

2018 Jurors:

Suku Park

Suku is an internationally renowned ceramic artist from South Korea. Among his many accomplishments, he is a member of the International Academy of Ceramics in Geneva, Switzerland. He has works in collections in 11 countries including Canada at the Royal Ontario Museum in Toronto and the Ceramic & Glass Gallery in Waterloo.

June Simpson

June, a Kirkland Lake native has been painting for 60 years. She has been a member of the Kirkland Lake Arts Club since 1975 and the Contemporary Art Committee since 2009. She works in acrylics and watercolours with a special interest in Kirkland Lake nostalgia.

Amanta Scott

Amanta is an award winning artist with works encompassing painting, sculpture, installation, sound, video, music, performance and storytelling. She has exhibited and performed in art galleries, museums, theatres, concert venues and festivals throughout Asia, North America and Europe. Her work is also held in collections across North America and Asia. She holds a MA in Art History & Comparative Literature and the Arts.

2018 Guest Artist:

Suku Park (South Korea)

Categories of Entry:

- **2 dimensional work**
(max. dimensions 60 in. x 60 in., including frame)
(max. weight of 15lbs. for wall art)
- **3 dimensional work**
(must be able to fit through a regular single doorway, 32 in. wide)
- **Performance & Video Works (Music, Story Telling, Dance Theatre)**
(No longer than 5 minutes not including credits)

Entry Rules:

1. An artist may submit a maximum of **TWO** entries in each category. All work must be original, created by the entrant, no older than two years and not previously shown at the Museum of Northern History.
2. **A brief (80 words max.) written synopsis of each work must be included with the entry.**
3. All 2 dimensional and 3 dimensional works must be properly wired and prepared for hanging/displaying. Works **NOT** prepared for display may not be considered.
4. **Shipping of work to and from the exhibit is the sole responsibility of the artist.** The MNH and Committee assume no responsibility or liability for loss or damage that may occur in transit or off of Museum property, or any damages which occur 48 hours after the exhibition and Museum insurance coverage ends.
5. All shipping and packaging materials must be labelled with the artists name and works, and including an inventory of all materials necessary for shipping.
6. Items will be inspected upon arrival, then photographed and catalogued. Any damage will be reported to the owner immediately.
7. Entries that are accepted must be on display from **April 6th to May 5th, 2018**. They must be picked up no later than **4pm on May 7th, 2018**. After that, a ten dollar fee will be charged per day as the museum does not have the space to accommodate excess artwork.
8. The exhibit is juried by **digital images and video files. Do not send original artwork.** Only representations of the work need to be submitted and originals will be delivered if accepted. Digital files on CD must be jpeg format, about 1MB in size and readable on a PC. For sculpture entries, please submit at least 2 images per artwork. Entries will also be accepted by email to museum@tkl.ca

9. Each entry must be received at the Museum of Northern History by **Tuesday, March 13th, 2018**. Entries will also be accepted by email to museum@tkl.ca, no later than **2pm on March 13th, 2018**.
 - **NOTE:** Do not submit original work at this time.
 - The Museum of Northern History and Contemporary Art Committee will not be responsible for loss or damage to materials submitted by mail.
10. The digital jurying will be the final selection for works accepted for the show.
11. Successful entrants will be notified by phone or email.
12. **Accepted works** must be received by the Museum of Northern History no later than **March 31st, 2018**.
13. Sales: Should an artist choose to have their work for sale, a **25%** commission is deducted from the sale price. The Artist must include this commission in the price they set and record that price on the entry form. **20% of sales will go to the Museum; the remaining 5% will go to the Contemporary Art Committee. ALL works must include an insurance value even if “Not For Sale” – if a value is not provided, a \$150.00 value will be assigned.**
